

Even in charz, there is safety. >> One of my favorite transformations in this project was taking two coat closets with boring standard doors and building new openings to house matching 9-foottall salvage doors from Urban Market Medina in Medina, Minnesota, to give the entry a European air and add scale to the 18-foot-tall entry wall. Wood always warms large areas of plain drywall. We then added 9-foot-tall cremone bolt hardware for adornment. Notice the cremone bolts that coordinate with the Salerno Cabinet from Ballard Designs in the piano room. The Simone Chandelier from Pottery Barn and chairs from The Sitting Room (Excelsior, Minnesota) add a luxury look and feel to the carpeted space.
